





For the 18th year running, Germany's great hat fair, Mut zum Hut, was held in the Renaissance Castle of Neuburg an der Donau.

Mut Zum Hut 2016 took place from the 23rd - 25th September and, as usual, attracted thousands of visitors from across Germany and the rest of the world. Founder and chief organiser Ute Patel-Missfeldt (pictured on the previous page) was joined by her daughter Isabell Patel to welcome more than 100 exhibitors from across Europe to sell hats, jewellery and accessories at the event.

German hat designer Ruth Eberz, who had a stall at Mut Zum Hut this year, told us, "There is always a special atmosphere in this historical place and Ute's fashion shows during the fair are a highlight." True to form, the opening show was a real spectacle. The 20s theme, which included a tango, delighted the audience.

An annual Mut Zum Hut tradition is the selection of a new Hat King and Queen.
